**COMPLAINT FOR COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT
AND RELATED CAUSES OF ACTION**

Plaintiff, DeVry/Becker Educational Development Corp., for its complaint against
Defendants, John Does Nos. 1 - 10, alleges as follows:

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

1. This is an action for copyright infringement, fraud, and violation of the federal Computer Fraud and Abuse Act. All claims arise out of the same set of operative facts.
2. This court has jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1331, 28 U.S.C. § 1338 and 28 U.S.C. § 1367.
3. Venue is proper in the Northern District of Illinois under 28 U.S.C. § 1391 because, *inter alia*, at least one of the Defendants resides in this District, because a substantial portion of the events giving rise to Plaintiff's claims occurred in this District, and because Defendants' intentional tortious activities have caused damage to Plaintiff, which resides in this District.

THE PARTIES

4. Plaintiff, DeVry/Becker Educational Development Corp. (“Plaintiff” or “DeVry”), is a Delaware corporation having an address of One Tower Lane, Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois 60181.

5. On information and belief, Defendant John Doe No. 1 is a resident of Elmhurst, Illinois.

6. On information and belief, Defendant John Doe No. 2 is a resident of Illinois.

7. On information and belief, Defendants John Does Nos. 3-10 have acted in concert with John Does Nos. 1, 2 or both to accomplish the copyright infringement, fraud, and other tortious acts described herein.

8. This Court has personal jurisdiction over Defendants, *inter alia*, pursuant to 735 ILCS 5/2-209 in that Defendants have committed intentional tortious acts in the State of Illinois, which acts constitute the subject matter of this action.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

9. DeVry offers one of the premier study courses, called the “Becker CPA Review,” for individuals taking the exam to become a Certified Public Accountant. DeVry’s students for this course are located throughout the United States.

10. All students enrolling in the Becker CPA Review course receive licence to use a set of textbooks, computer software, and video lectures on CD-ROM designed to make the studying process more effective. DeVry does not sell those materials, but rather only grants licenses to use them.

11. DeVry has registered its copyrights in its textbooks, computer software, and video

lectures on CD-ROM with the United States Copyright Office. Those materials are registered under the title “Becker CPA Review Course Materials (textbooks and CD-ROMs, Version 4.0)” and have been given Registration Number PA-1-318-550. A copy of this Registration is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

12. DeVry also provides a set of flashcards designed to augment the content taught in the Becker CPA Review course.

13. DeVry has registered the copyright in the flashcards with the United States Copyright Office. The flashcards are registered under the title “Becker CPA Review Course Materials (flashcards)” and has been given Registration Number TX-6-452-058. A copy of this Registration is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

14. DeVry maintains a computer database that it uses to track and process orders of the Becker CPA Review course materials (the “Order Database”).

15. In DeVry’s regular course of business, it electronically sends information for fulfillment of legitimate orders of Becker CPA Review course materials from the Order Database to a shipping warehouse facility.

THE 2006 UNAUTHORIZED SHIPMENTS

16. On numerous occasions between March 2006 and October 2006, John Doe No. 1 gained access to the Order Database and inserted and manipulated information contained therein.

17. John Doe No. 1 did not have authority or authorization from DeVry to access the Order Database or to make the data insertions or manipulations which he did.

18. During the unauthorized intrusions into the Order Database, John Doe No. 1 created counterfeit orders for Becker CPA Review course materials.

19. Plaintiff does not know the true name of John Doe No. 1 at this time. However, Plaintiff's computer logs recorded the Internet Protocol ("IP") address and date and time of a number of instances of creation or manipulation of the counterfeit orders. Each of those IP addresses was in a pool used by subscribers to AT&T Internet Services. In public databases, those IP addresses have a geographic tag of Elmhurst, Illinois. Plaintiff believes that information obtained in discovery will lead to the identification of John Doe No. 1's true name.

20. Each of the 2006 counterfeit orders for Becker CPA Review course materials directed that such materials should be shipped to a single residence in New York (the "New York Residence").

21. After the information for each counterfeit order was sent to DeVry's shipping warehouse facility for fulfillment, John Doe No. 1 altered the counterfeit order to disguise the fact that it had been sent to the New York Residence.

22. As a result of the counterfeit orders created by John Doe No. 1, DeVry shipped fifty-four (54) separate orders of Becker CPA Review course materials to the New York Residence between March 17, 2006 and October 11, 2006.

23. The retail value of the Becker CPA Review course materials in those fifty-four shipments to the New York Residence exceeds \$180,000.

THE 2007 UNAUTHORIZED SHIPMENTS

24. On at least seven occasions between January 3, 2007 and March 3, 2007, John Doe No. 2 gained access to the Order Database and inserted and manipulated information contained therein.

25. John Doe No. 2 did not have authority or authorization from DeVry to access the

Order Database or to make the data insertions or manipulations which he did.

26. During the unauthorized intrusions into the Order Database, John Doe No. 2 created counterfeit orders for Becker CPA Review course materials.

27. Plaintiff does not know the true name of John Doe No. 2 at this time. However, Plaintiff's computer logs recorded the Internet Protocol ("IP") address and date and time of a number of instances of creation or manipulation of the counterfeit orders. Each of those IP addresses was in a pool used by subscribers to Comcast Cable Communications. In public databases, those IP addresses have a geographic tag associated with Illinois. Plaintiff believes that information obtained in discovery will lead to the identification of John Doe No. 2's true name.

28. Each of the 2007 counterfeit orders for Becker CPA Review course materials directed that such materials should be shipped to a single residence in Pennsylvania (the "Pennsylvania Residence").

29. After the information for each counterfeit order was sent to DeVry's shipping warehouse facility for fulfillment, John Doe No. 2 altered the counterfeit order to disguise the fact that it had been sent to the Pennsylvania Residence.

30. As a result of the counterfeit orders created by John Doe No. 2, DeVry shipped seven (7) separate orders of Becker CPA Review course materials to the Pennsylvania Residence between January 3, 2007 and March 15, 2007.

31. The retail value of the Becker CPA Review course materials in those seven shipments to the Pennsylvania Residence exceeds \$20,000.

COUNT I - COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT (JOHN DOE NO. 1)

32. DeVry adopts and realleges paragraphs 1 through 31.

33. DeVry owns the copyrights in the Becker CPA Review course materials.

34. John Doe No. 1 distributed copies of the Becker CPA Review course materials without DeVry's permission.

35. DeVry had not sold, licensed or otherwise made any authorized transfer of the Becker CPA Review course materials which John Doe No. 1 distributed.

36. DeVry has been damaged by the actions of John Doe No. 1.

COUNT II - COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT (JOHN DOE NO. 2)

37. DeVry adopts and realleges paragraphs 1 through 36.

38. DeVry owns the copyrights in the Becker CPA Review course materials.

39. John Doe No. 2 distributed copies of the Becker CPA Review course materials without DeVry's permission.

40. DeVry had not sold, licensed or otherwise made any authorized transfer of the Becker CPA Review course materials which John Doe No. 2 distributed.

41. DeVry has been damaged by the actions of John Doe No. 2.

COUNT III - FRAUD (JOHN DOE NO. 1)

42. DeVry adopts and realleges paragraphs 1 through 41.

43. John Doe No. 1 made numerous false statements of material fact by creating counterfeit orders in DeVry's Order Database.

44. John Doe No. 1 knew that these statements were false, in that the alleged purchasing parties had not actually paid for any Becker CPA Review course materials or

enrolled in any DeVry courses.

45. John Doe No. 1 intended that the false statements embodied in the counterfeit orders would cause DeVry to send Becker CPA Review course materials to the New York Residence.

46. DeVry relied on the false statements embodied in the counterfeit orders and sent Becker CPA Review course materials to the New York Residence.

47. DeVry has been damaged by relying on the false statements of John Doe No. 1.

COUNT IV - FRAUD (JOHN DOE NO. 2)

48. DeVry adopts and realleges paragraphs 1 through 47.

49. John Doe No. 2 made numerous false statements of material fact by creating counterfeit orders in DeVry's Order Database.

50. John Doe No. 2 knew that these statements were false, in that the alleged purchasing parties had not actually paid for any Becker CPA Review course materials or enrolled in any DeVry courses.

51. John Doe No. 2 intended that the false statements embodied in the counterfeit orders would cause DeVry to send Becker CPA Review course materials to the Pennsylvania Residence.

52. DeVry relied on the false statements embodied in the counterfeit orders and sent Becker CPA Review course materials to the Pennsylvania Residence.

53. DeVry has been damaged by relying on the false statements of John Doe No. 2.

COUNT V - FEDERAL COMPUTER FRAUD & ABUSE ACT (JOHN DOE NO. 1)

54. DeVry adopts and realleges paragraphs 1 through 53.

55. The Order Database resides on one or more DeVry computers which qualify as protected computers under 18 U.S.C. § 1030.

56. John Doe No. 1 accessed the Order Database knowingly and with an intent to defraud DeVry.

57. John Doe No. 1 accessed the Order Database without DeVry's authorization.

58. John Doe No. 1 created counterfeit orders on and made other changes to the Order Database without DeVry's authorization.

59. The unauthorized actions of John Doe No. 1 in manipulating the Order Database caused Defendants to obtain by fraud valuable copies of Becker CPA Review course materials.

60. DeVry has been damaged by the actions of John Doe No. 1.

COUNT VI - FEDERAL COMPUTER FRAUD & ABUSE ACT (JOHN DOE NO. 2)

61. DeVry adopts and realleges paragraphs 1 through 60.

62. The Order Database resides on one or more DeVry computers which qualify as protected computers under 18 U.S.C. § 1030.

63. John Doe No. 2 accessed the Order Database knowingly and with an intent to defraud DeVry.

64. John Doe No. 2 accessed the Order Database without DeVry's authorization.

65. John Doe No. 2 created counterfeit orders on and made other changes to the Order Database without DeVry's authorization.

66. The unauthorized actions of John Doe No. 2 in manipulating the Order Database caused Defendants to obtain by fraud valuable copies of Becker CPA Review course materials.

67. DeVry has been damaged by the actions of John Doe No. 2.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, DeVry/Becker Educational Development Corp., respectfully requests this Court to enter:

1. Judgment for Plaintiff and against John Doe No. 1 on Count I for copyright infringement in violation of 17 U.S.C. § 501.

2. Judgment for Plaintiff and against John Doe No. 2 on Count II for copyright infringement in violation of 17 U.S.C. § 501.

3. Judgment for Plaintiff and against John Doe No. 1 on Count III for fraud under the common law.

4. Judgment for Plaintiff and against John Doe No. 2 on Count IV for fraud under the common law.

5. Judgment for Plaintiff and against Defendant John Doe No. 1 on Count V for violation of the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act, 18 U.S.C. § 1030.

6. Judgment for Plaintiff and against Defendant John Doe No. 2 on Count VI for violation of the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act, 18 U.S.C. § 1030.

7. A preliminary and permanent injunction restraining Defendants, and their heirs, agents, servants, representatives, successors, assigns, assignees and all persons acting in active concert or participation with Defendants, or on behalf of Defendants, from doing, causing, aiding or abetting any of the following:

- a. Accessing or manipulating any information in DeVry's Order Database.
- b. Offering for sale, selling, or distributing any illicitly obtained Becker CPA Review course materials or copies thereof.

8. An order requiring Defendants to turn over to Plaintiff all illicitly obtained Becker CPA Review materials and any copies thereof still in Defendants' possession.

9. An order requiring Defendants to pay over to Plaintiff all damages suffered by Plaintiff as a result of Defendants' copyright infringement, fraud and violation of the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act.

10. An order requiring Defendants to pay Plaintiff's reasonable attorneys fees, expenses, and costs incurred in this action.


11. An order granting such other relief as this Court may deem just.
